The following summarises the key themes from comments provided by the survey respondents.

Biosecurity Strategy

- In the event of an outbreak it is better to learn to adapt to the incursion rather than undertake elimination. Eradication efforts can do more harm than the incursion itself.
- Beekeepers worldwide deal with numerous pests and diseases and still make a profit.
- Need to maintain a prevention focus including education via beekeeping clubs.
- Our industry has several key biosecurity threats. We can't fund the prevention of all of them.

Funding

- Costs should be met by those responsible for bringing in the incursion.
- Ultimately seen as MPI's responsibility so MPI ought to be fully funding response costs.
- The sector pays a lot of tax and considers that this should be used to fund biosecurity.
- Need to consider funding means. For example, per beehive. This would be equitable for small apiaries and easier to implement.
- Exporters and importers need to play a stronger role in biosecurity funding.
- More information on full costs would be useful for making an informed decision.
- Beekeepers don't have the means to fully fund an outbreak.
- Keen to understand the funding implications, particularly with respect to administration costs.

Signing Implications

- Signing the GIA ought to give the apiculture sector influence over other aspects of the sector, for example, importers.
- There is some concern that the GIA won't benefit all aspects of the sector, particularly hobbyists.

Consultation

- Ought to be wider than just this industry to ensure that all affected parties are captured by this process.
- The survey didn't allow all funding options to be voted on.
