

Bee Aware Month Learn about honey

1. Bees suck nectar from flowers with their long tongues (proboscis).

2. Bees carry nectar to their hive in their special honey stomach. Enzymes in their stomach change the nectar into honey. **6.** Beekeepers take the honey off the hive (but 3. Bees store the leave enough for the bees!) honey in honey comb cells. 7. We eat it! Draw a picture here of a person eating honey! **5.** Bees seal the honey in the honey comb with a wax cap so it will keep well. 4. Bees fan their wings really fast to dry the moisture out of the honey.
