Open category that can include crafts.</b>	Non specified, added value or alternative use criteria apply. Key elements are originality, innovation, presentation & quality. A collection can be supplied as one entry.  Products must include a list of ingredients and state the percentage of <b>New Zealand</b> bee products used in the product. For beekeepers that supply honey to a manufacture of these products, they are encouraged to supply a letter that outlines the source and type of honey used. L		<b>People's Choice Award</b>	<p>The People's Choice Award entries are to be presented in Amber PET square jars, 400ml min 500g with no markings.</p> <p>Must be accompanied by a brief blurb about their honey e.g. type of honey, location etc. Open to all types of honey. **\*Winners of gold award in classes A – G** receive a trophy, certificate and 100 honey jar labels (and can negotiate with Kiwi Labels to print more).

**\*Winners of silver and bronze awards in classes A –G** receive a certificate, medal and 100 honey jar labels (and can negotiate with Kiwi Labels to print more).

**\*Winners of classes H – L** receive a certificate and a trophy.

**Judges reserve the right to award Gold Silver or Bronze based on the quality of entries. It could be appropriate to only award a bronze medal if points aren't high enough to award Gold or Silver. A trophy can only be awarded for a gold award.**
