Candidates may include an email address or website address, but these will each be counted as one word as part of the word limit.
- **Must** be confined to information concerning the candidate, and the candidate's policies and intentions if elected to Apiculture NZ (i.e. must not refer to any other candidate).
- Must include a recent photograph of the candidate only, i.e. a head and shoulders shot. Photos must be in an electronic format (scanned as a jpeg at a minimum of 300 dpi and emailed to memberships@apinz.org.nz).
