

BEES LIKE FLOWERS and FLOWERS LIKE BEES

Bees get yummy pollen and nectar from flowers.

Bees help flowers grow new plants by moving the pollen around (from stamen to pistil) to make new seeds (in the ovary).

COLOUR

Can you colour in the parts of the flower using different colours for each part?

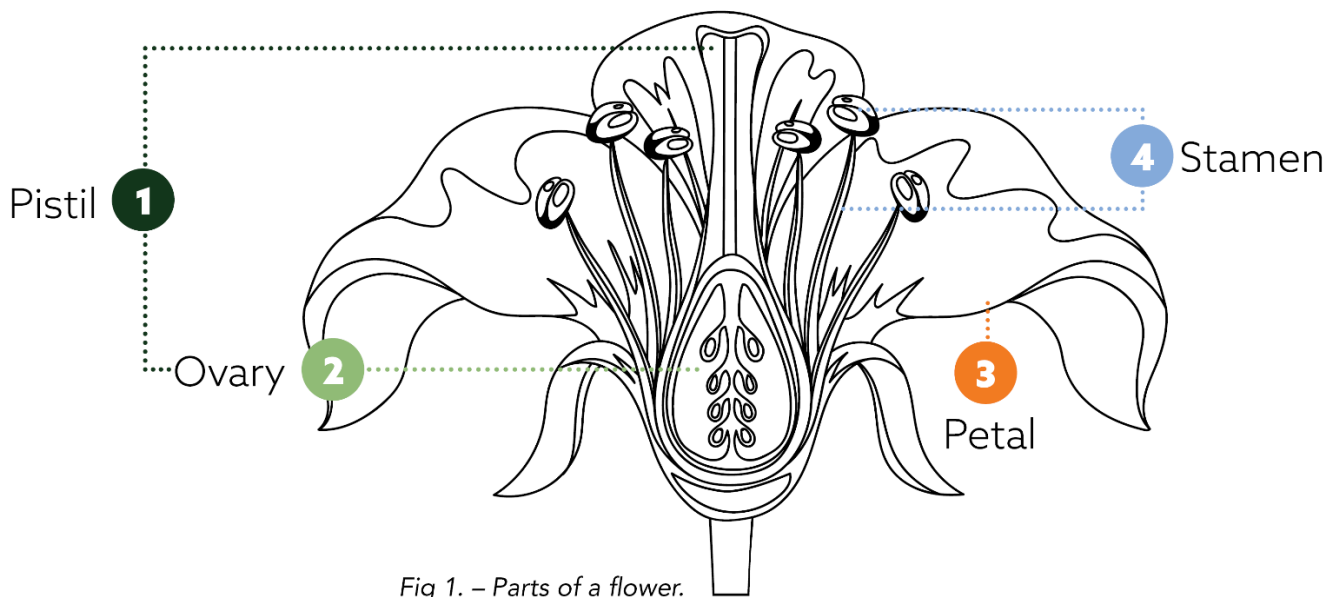


Fig 1. – Parts of a flower.
